


BY LAWS OF THE HS-6 RAUNCHY REDSKINS

Be it known to all Redskins (officers) of HS-6 that these are the by laws of all Pow-wows (meeting) which are held by the Redskins. Anyone not adhering to these by laws shall be subjected to cruel and heartless tortures as directed by the Chief Raunchy Redskin.

1. Pow-wows shall be held a minimum of once a month or as declared by the Chief Raunchy Redskin at any time the camp is troubled by the winds of hate and discontent. (The Chief is opened to any recommendations as to when an ill wind is in the camp.)
2. Membership birchbarks (cards) shall be presented at all pow-wows which will be held at the Happy Lodge (O Club) or any other convenient place. At this time great quantities of firewater will begin to be consumed.
3. No squaws will be allowed at the pow-wows. They should remain in their wigwams and keep their sleeping blankets warm for their Redskins when they return. Smoke signals (telephone calls) from the squaws will result in the unhappiness of the war party (Committee). Redskins should use discretion and not break their arrows while under the influence of the firewater.
4. The two youngest Redskins (junior Ensigns) are hereby designated to be the Foreskins and shall be charged with the duties of keeping the other Redskins' cups filled with firewater. They shall remain conspicuously located during the entire pow-wow to provide more expeditious service to the other Redskins. Proper attire for the Foreskins shall be moccasins, headbands, battle dress, and war paint.
5. Any Redskin whose voice breaks the silence as the chattering of the crows (speaks without permission) shall be subject to the wrath of the Firewater God.
6. Blood brothers will be accepted into the tribe from HS-10 (ugh) after the ordeal of the Firewater.
7. The Chief Raunchy Redskin and the warparty shall be exempt from harrassment of any kind at the pow-wow.
8. The Redskin whose head is as the splitting rock and whose sight is as that of the catfish caused by the ordeal of the Firewater shall ride home on the pony of another Redskin to keep him from the danger of the longknives (California Highway Patrol).
9. The junior Foreskin shall keep custody of the Chief Raunchy Redskins attire between Pow-wows.
